No-Cost Grief Support Group

Anyone in the parish who has experienced the recent, or not-so-recent, death of a loved one is invited to participate in a *grief support group* this summer for members of St. Stephen's. The group will meet weekly for seven weeks, beginning in June, either in the early afternoon or early evening, depending on the preferences of the group participants. Sessions will include some educational materials, as well as extended time for sharing of thoughts, feelings, and experiences of the group members.

The group will be led by Steve Herbes, MSSW. Steve is a retired professional counselor who has led more than 40 grief support groups during the past 25 years. During the past two decades Steve has experienced again and again, the *power of a support group to help grieving persons heal*.
