EVANGELISM

Evangelism is, at its basics, the sharing of the Good News. The staple ministry of our evangelism is Bread Upon the Waters, our newcomer ministry (our greeters with the green name tags!) which greets and becomes an initial point of contact for our newcomers. Beginning this fall, we are introducing a ministry called Invite, Welcome, Connect which stresses the added importance of reaching out to people about our church and then, on the other side, developing a more comprehensive way for new members to find their place within the wider community. Evangelism is the work of the entire congregation, not just a handful of people. But we are always looking for people who love to talk to others and would love to take an intentional role as an evangelist.
