Although we are newly formed, Together Podemos has already made a significant impact. We were able to assist approximately 22 families and 62 individuals, providing them with the necessary resources and knowledge to improve their well-being.

Additionally, we have worked in collaboration with other organizations to aid two families facing homelessness. For the second year in a row, we partnered with the Anderson County School system during registration day to assist Hispanic families with the registration process by bridging the language barrier.

We have also established strong partnerships with The Oak Ridge Family Justice Center, TORCH, Ecumenical Storehouse, KARM, YWCA, Centro Hispano de East TN, and the Catholic Charities of East TN. These alliances have significantly expanded our reach and impact, highlighting the strength and effectiveness that comes from working together as a community.
