MINISTRY OF THE WEEK!

Altar Guild is the ministry of caring for everything that relates to the Altar (the table on which Holy Eucharist is celebrated). The duties of the Guild involve preparation for church services on weekdays and Sundays, festival days and special occasions (including weddings, funerals and baptisms), and "closing" (cleanup) after each service. Other Altar Guild responsibilities include:

Caring for the linens and vessels used in all services as well as brass furnishings and paragons (altar frontals, hangings, banners, etc.)

Caring for vestments and other liturgical garments

Arranging for flowers

Replenishing the supply of wafers, bread, wine and candles

Our work goes on quietly behind the scenes and is often unnoticed, since worshipers do not ordinarily think about the usual furnishings of the altar and sanctuary, or who has put them out or who cares for them. However, Altar Guild members are faithfully on duty year round. There is room for anyone who would like to serve.

Together Podemos is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization that was established in April of this year. Our mission is to ensure that the Hispanic community has fair access to the resources available in the area. In addition, we provide workshops and programs that offer knowledge in social, civic, legal, and financial matters, as well as an understanding of the distinctive factors of the community, to encourage adaptability, empowerment, and integration to the community.

Although we are newly formed, Together Podemos has already made a significant impact. We were able to assist approximately 22 families and 62 individuals, providing them with the necessary resources and knowledge to improve their well-being.

Additionally, we have worked in collaboration with other organizations to aid two families facing homelessness. For the second year in a row, we partnered with the Anderson County School system during registration day to assist Hispanic families with the registration process by bridging the language barrier.

We have also established strong partnerships with The Oak Ridge Family Justice Center, TORCH, Ecumenical Storehouse, KARM, YWCA, Centro Hispano de East TN, and the Catholic Charities of East TN. Alliances that have significantly expanded our reach and impact, highlighting the strength and effectiveness that comes from working together as a community.
