Our special Outreach project has a two-part focus: Firstly, funding the Blankets+ Campaign conducted by Church Women United for Church World Service (CWS), and secondly, collecting new or clean gently used bedding for the Ecumenical Storehouse in Oak Ridge.

Every \$10 will buy a specially made large, durable blanket suitable for the recipients' climate.
